Friday 9th February - FROZEN FRIDAY:

Friday 23rd February - PTFA FAMILY PICNIC:

This picnic is a wonderful informal gathering of our school community where you are invited to bring a picnic, chairs, rugs and beverages and the children have the option of bringing their togs for a swim in the school pool (under your parental supervision of course!).

The PTFA will provide a sausage sizzle (\$2 a sausage) and cold drinks (\$2 a can) so you can simply turn up and be fed and watered. This is a wonderful opportunity to get to know your fellow parents and a great way to start our year.

Tuesday 12th March – AGM and first PFTA meeting for this year:

This will be held at **7pm** in the staffroom. At this meeting the **a**nnual **g**eneral **m**eeting (AGM) will be held, where we go over the achievements of last year and assess the PTFA finances. We also accept nominations and vote for the elected key positions of responsibility for the year – Chair, Secretary and Treasurer. This meeting is generally a little longer than usual as we will plan a schedule of events for the upcoming year, including our fundraising and community activities.

For those new to St Johns, the term PTFA may be an unfamiliar one. PTFA stands for the $\underline{\mathbf{P}}$ arent $\underline{\mathbf{T}}$ eacher and $\underline{\mathbf{F}}$ riends $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ ssociation. By simply being a parent/caregiver to a child at the school you automatically belong to the PTFA. Whilst the vast majority of attendees at our meetings are parents/caregivers, we are well supported by teachers, the St John's School Board and the principal, Miss Binns, as well as friends of the school.

The PTFA meets at the school, once a month, currently on a Tuesday evening for 1~2 hours to plan events and fundraisers as well as to discuss how we can best support our school community. We introduced virtual attendance to the meeting last year so if you are unable to be there in person, you can log in from home. It is always attended by the principal and a Board representative so it is a fantastic way to get to know the workings of the school. Although we run to an Agenda, the meeting itself is quite informal and everyone is given the opportunity to speak. Agenda items are called for in advance, so if you wish to raise anything specific you have the opportunity to prepare. It is also the best way for you to express your thoughts on which of the projects, in consultation with the School Board, we will be fundraising for throughout the year.
