Tomorrow we celebrate Catholic School's Day. Catholic Schools have a long history in New Zealand, dating back to 1841 and play an integral part in the education system in NZ. There are over 66,900 students in 187 primary and 48 secondary Catholic Schools across the country, with 23,500 in the Auckland Diocese.

Pope Francis designated 2025 as the Church's Year of Jubilee: Pilgrims of Hope. In line with this, the theme for this year is **Shine like stars in the world: E tīaho ana koe hei rama i te ao.** 

Classes will be sharing their morning prayer in the church with the parish to acknowledge the partnership between the parish and the school. Children will also share some time with their buddies talking about what makes a Catholic School special. They will create a sticker which they will wear home. Please take a minute to talk to them about it.

To help showcase Catholic Schools to our communities, the children will be bringing home two lollipops; one for them to enjoy and one to give to someone who doesn't go to our school. This could be a sibling, family member or someone else known to them.
