Whilst the majority of attendees at our meetings are parents/caregivers, we are well supported by teachers, the School Board and our principal, Miss Binns.

The PTFA meets at the school, once a month, currently on a Tuesday evening for ~1 hours to plan events and fundraisers as well as to discuss how we can best support our school community. We have a virtual option so if you are unable to be there in person, you can log in from home. It is always attended by the principal and a Board representative so it is a fantastic way to get to know the workings of the school. Although we run to an Agenda, the meeting itself is quite informal and everyone is given the opportunity to speak. Agenda items are called for in advance, so if you wish to raise anything specific you have the opportunity to prepare.
